A Reengagement Center is a site or organization that conducts active outreach to engage youth (16 to 24) who are out of school and not working and assist them in resuming their education and/or training to become career ready. A Reengagement Center may also provide individualized assessment, case management, and other services to support youth in returning to school or work.

- Agree to aggregate data collection and annual data entry
- Complete Quality Standards Baseline Assessment
- Provide ongoing feedback
- Meet all agreed upon deadlines
- Provide resources to support this effort
- Agree to partner collaboratively with OFY referring organizations
- Provide training to cohort members based on area of expertise as appropriate
- Agree to put OFY logo on your website
- Notification of change in participation status
